

# Stop Unwanted Calls

**Register your numbers with the National Do Not Call Registry**  
(1-888-382-1222 or online at [www.DoNotCall.gov](http://www.DoNotCall.gov))



**Ask your local phone company about custom calling features**

Use these star codes:

**Selective Call Rejection (\*60)** - Allows you to program your phone to block unwanted calls from numbers placed on your rejection list.

**Anonymous Call Rejection (\*77)** - Stops your phone from ringing when callers have blocked their number.

**Selective Call Acceptance (\*64)** - Allows you to limit incoming calls to a preapproved list of phone numbers.



**Consider a call-blocking device**

These devices come with a spam call database so you can block hundreds of calls instantly. They can reject calls shown as private, international, unknown, or fake numbers or reject calls from a state, area, or international country code. Purchase call-blocking devices at major retailers or online.
