

Stop Unwanted Calls

On Your Landline



Register your numbers with the National Do Not Call Registry
(1-888-382-1222 or online at www.DoNotCall.gov)



Ask your local phone company about custom calling features

Use these star codes:

Selective Call Rejection (*60) - Allows you to program your phone to block unwanted calls from numbers placed on your rejection list.

Anonymous Call Rejection (*77) - Stops your phone from ringing when callers have blocked their number.

Selective Call Acceptance (*64) - Allows you to limit incoming calls to a preapproved list of phone numbers.



Contact your landline and cell phone carrier

Most carriers have free call-blocking and spam-filtering services using advanced technology to identify and block scam and spam calls before they reach you. Many also offer free call-screening apps that display warnings like "Spam Risk" or "Scam Likely" on your phone's screen or Caller ID.
